Musician, 33 years old

APPREHENDED: February 2025.

DEPORTED: March 14, 2025. To CECOT a maximum-security prison in El Salvador

BACKGROUND: In 2014 he joined mass protests against the government in Venezuela. Later he moved to Columbia and then Chile. There he installed refrigerators and also started a musical career and met his wife. Sept. 3, 2024, he entered the United States using the CBP One app. He was allowed in with an order to appear in court on March 6, 2025. Meanwhile, he worked in landscaping with his brother in North Carolina. On Feb. 8, he was at a house in Raleigh, NC, to record a music video. US immigration officials arrested him there and he ended up in detention in Georgia. In March he was moved to Texas and then deported to El Salvador and imprisoned there. He did not face a day in court; he was never formally accused of any criminal activity.

OTHER FACTS: CBS News could not find criminal records for 75% of Venezuelans sent to El Salvador (60 Minutes April 6, 2025). Of the nearly 250 Venezuelans sent to El Salvador 50 of them entered the US legally and never violated Immigration laws. (CATO Institute Blog, May 19, 2025)
